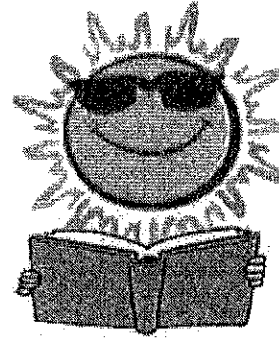


Hi !! This year instead of running off summer packets for the entire school, we have posted them on our website. All packets can be found at:

The packet is due within the first week of school. **Please complete the permission slip below to acknowledge you have read this information and return it to school.**

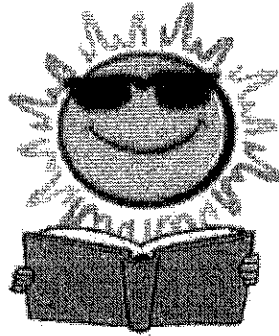
